



Anvil Centre COVID-19 Protocols

After many weeks of holding strong and working together to protect the health of our communities, the announcement of British Columbia's Re-Start Plan is the green light we have been waiting for to begin re-opening Anvil Centre.

The health and safety of our staff and guests are our top priority. Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, the team at Anvil Centre has been working collaboratively with industry associations, peers and taking direction from governing authorities such as WorkSafeBC and Fraser Health Authority to ensure that we are following 'Best Practices'.

Many changes and new protocols will be in place when you arrive at Anvil Centre. As the venue will not be open to the general public, you will be greeted at the door by Anvil staff who will provide access only to guests that are attending scheduled events and other activities on site.

All Anvil Centre staff are trained in the 'new normal' COVID-19 protocols. All front of house and service staff will be wearing masks and many staff wearing disposable gloves. Acrylic screens and signs with detailed COVID-19 Protocols are in place along with updated 'no touch' equipment.

Physical distancing will be managed with directional arrows in public spaces, meeting / event spaces will have one door for ingress and one door for egress and floor plans for event set-ups have all been updated to allow for appropriate distancing. We strongly recommend that guests wear non-medical masks. Attendance lists will be required as occupancy tracking is in place and each attendee will be required to complete a health check form at the ground floor Information Kiosk before moving to the event space.

Each event space will have a Sanitizing Station within the room. This includes disposable gloves & disposable masks, hospital grade disinfectant wipes, hand sanitizer and tissue for guests.

All event spaces will be disinfected prior to your event, during your event and post event. Our trained cleaning staff will disinfect your event space during all breaks. Touch free coffee and meal services will be the 'new normal'.

Prior to your guests coming on site, all must self-screen for any COVID-19 symptoms such as fever, shortness of breath, sore throat, stuffy or runny nose, loss of smell, headache, muscle aches or loss of appetite and should not attend if any symptoms are present.. If any guests or anyone who lives with them are either ill or quarantined, they must not attend the event. Any guests who develop symptoms at the event will be required to leave.
